

Robert P. Morin Literary Award

PURPOSE OF THE AWARD

To provide an incentive to Edmonton Chapter members to shape their ideas and experiences by writing and publishing articles on Records and Information Management.

CRITERIA

1. All articles must be 250 words or more in length.
2. Articles must have been published in a recognized records and information management publication that is distributed in Edmonton (eg: Scopenotes; Information Management, for the ARMA year (July 1 – June 30) in which the award is being presented.
3. Articles will be judged on the basis of relevance to topic, clarity, style, content and format.
4. A rating system will be developed by the Awards Committee.
5. Only ARMA – Edmonton Chapter members will be eligible for this award.

AWARD

\$150.00 in cash and a letter of congratulations attesting to the award.

TIMING

This award will be announced and presented at the June meeting.

General Information:

1. Authors should be encouraged to apply for the award themselves but may be nominated by someone else.
2. A maximum of five applications per individual will be allowed.
3. The Awards Committee may secure individuals, not necessarily of ARMA, to help judge the articles.
